

Holiday Let Guest Instructions Sheet

Welcome

We hope you enjoy your hot tub experience whilst on holiday. Please find enclosed a list of important guidelines to make sure everyone has a safe, relaxing, and enjoyable time. Following these instructions also helps us keep the spa in excellent condition for all guests.

■ Do's

Do shower before use

Please shower before getting into the hot tub. This removes oils, lotions, fake tan, and other products that can quickly upset the water balance and cause foam or cloudy water.

Do replace the cover after use

Always secure the hot tub cover when the spa is not in use. This keeps the water warm, prevents accidents, and saves energy.

Do supervise children at all times

Children must always be supervised in and around the hot tub. Young children should never be left unattended.

Do limit bathing time

For your own comfort and health, bathing should be limited to 15–20 minutes at a time. Take breaks to cool down and rehydrate with water.

Do respect the maximum number of bathers

Please follow the maximum occupancy stated for this spa. Overloading the hot tub can strain the system, reduce water quality, and cause damage.

■ Don'ts

Don't use glass in or around the hot tub

Broken glass is a serious hazard. Please only use plastic glasses or bottles near the spa.

Don't consume excessive alcohol

Using the hot tub while intoxicated can be dangerous. Alcohol increases the risk of dehydration, fainting, and accidents.

Don't use if pregnant or unwell

Pregnant guests or those with medical conditions should consult a doctor before using a hot tub. Avoid use if you are feeling unwell, have open wounds, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Don't add soaps or oils

Please do not add bubble bath, bath oils, or any other products to the water. These can cause foaming, block filters, and damage the spa.

Don't adjust controls or temperature

The hot tub has been set to a safe and comfortable temperature. Please do not attempt to change the temperature or alter the control settings.

■ Final Notes

Please treat the hot tub with care so that everyone can enjoy it. If you notice any problems with water quality, unusual noises, or error messages on the display, stop using the spa and contact your holiday let host immediately.
